Definitions

- **Learn & Create:** organiser/staff of the retreat
- **Retreat:** bag making retreat taking place Monday 25th May - Wednesday 27th May 2026
- **Participant:** Anyone taking part in the retreat activities
- **Non-Participant:** Anyone staying at the retreat venue but not taking part in the retreat activities
- **Guest:** Participant or Non-Participant
- **PAT:** Portable appliance testing, the examination of electrical appliances and equipment to ensure they are safe to use

Guests

- All Guests must be 18 years old or older
- All Guests must be respectful and must not engage in offensive or illegal activities while attending the Retreat
- Learn & Create aims to be an all-inclusive space; welcome to anyone regardless of race, gender-identity, sexuality or disability. We want to ensure that our staff and guests at the Retreat are in an environment free of bullying, harassment, victimisation and unlawful discrimination
- Should a Guest behave inappropriately toward our staff or other Guests, we reserve the right to ask that Guest to leave the premises or suspend their activities if it is appropriate to do so, without any compensation.

Booking

- Agree to the terms and conditions
- Pay the deposit

Once we receive your booking we will ask you to complete a detailed booking form where you can highlight any dietary needs, room preferences, workshop options and any other retreat specific questions. Please complete this & return it promptly so we can confirm your preferences.

Cancellations

Cancellation by Learn & Create

In the unlikely event a retreat is cancelled by us a full refund will be given. Please see note on special circumstances

Cancellation by Guest

Time Period	Refund Amount
12+ weeks before retreat	100% of the original cost of the retreat, less the £100 non-refundable deposit, will be refunded
6-12 weeks before retreat	If the place can be reallocated 60% of the original cost of the retreat will be refunded. If the place cannot be reallocated no refund will be given
0-6 weeks before retreat	If the place can be reallocated 40% of the original cost of the retreat will be refunded. If the place cannot be reallocated no refund will be given

The above cancellation policy applies to all Guests. It is your responsibility to read and understand our cancellation policies.

Exceptions cannot be made for any reason (including weather, injury/illness, or personal emergencies). No refunds, apart from those listed above, will be given for failure to attend or failure to complete the retreat, or for arriving late or leaving early.

Refunds will be paid by Bank Transfer to the person named on the Booking Form.

Payments for partial refunds may not be paid until after the Retreat, to allow maximum time to reallocate the place. We will do our best to re-allocate spaces.

Transfer of Booking

Consequential Loss

Apart from refunds described above, we will not take responsibility for consequential losses if any aspect of a retreat needs to be changed.

We will not reimburse guests for associated alternative travel or accommodation costs.

All retreat participants must make themselves aware of the terms & conditions & accept the risks associated with the course activities, each guest must be responsible for taking out the appropriate insurance policy for the full duration of the retreat.

You are responsible for ensuring that you have a valid passport and any necessary visas, as well as any necessary or required injections or other health requirements.

We accept no responsibility for travel tickets such as airfares and public transport. This is solely the guest's responsibility to organize and inform us only of an accurate arrival time in their own vehicle.

Health & Safety

We will do all we can to ensure your well-being during the retreat but each Guest's personal health & safety is ultimately their own responsibility.

If while at the Retreat you spot anything that may compromise the safety and well-being of other guests, please report this immediately to a staff member. Any activities, trips or excursions outside the retreat location are taken at your own risk.

Medical Matters

Please notify us in the detailed booking form of any medical conditions that might affect your stay, or that of other Guests at the retreat. Learn & Create is not responsible if a Guest omits this information and suffers any adverse effects during their stay. We reserve the right to refuse a booking if we feel that we cannot reasonably cater for a Guest's medical condition and/or requirements.

Please note - there is one wheelchair accessible room at the venue & all but four bedrooms are located on the ground floor. The workshop and kitchen areas are all wheelchair accessible

Workshop Sessions

Workshop times will be set out in your retreat schedule - we will do our best to stick to these times but reserve the right to alter the schedule if need be (for example due to staff travel delays)

When workshops are not running all machines, equipment and projects must be removed from the main tables so that catering staff can set up for meals.

Use of Equipment

Equipment and tools (including sewing machines, Green Machine hand press, irons, cutting tools etc) will be provided by Learn & Create.

Guests are welcome to bring their own sewing machines. They are responsible for getting these PAT tested prior to the Retreat. This is a condition of our insurance & is non-negotiable. We will need to see that the sticker is present & in date before use.

Guests are also welcome to bring their own tools. They - and anyone they choose to share them with - are responsible for their safe use.

By agreeing to these terms & conditions you are confirming that you have basic knowledge of using these tools and if there is any feature, equipment or tool you are unfamiliar with you will ask our tutors for help.

Minor breakages such as broken/bent needles, pins, quilting clips will not incur any compensation.

Breakages to sewing machines, irons and equipment which result in repair or replacement will incur either full or part compensation

Property

We expect all Guests to respect the property of the owners, staff and fellow Guests.

Learn & Create is not liable for damage to Guests property unless directly caused by neglect on their part. Learn & Create do not accept for any loss or damage to any personal property or vehicle belonging to the Guests during the services.

Media

Learn & Create may take photographs or video during the retreat. This media may be used on our website, in promotional materials and advertisements (including print and digital).

Guests accept & agree that any photos or recordings may be used by Learn & Create at their absolute discretion
